MABOU MINES COVID-19 PROTOCOL



 Attendees are asked to stay home if they answer yes to any of the following questions:

a) do you have a fever above 100 degrees; b) have you tested positive for COVID within the last 14 days; c) do you have any of the well-known COVID symptoms d) have you been exposed to anyone who's tested positive in last 14 days, e) have you traveled outside of the state, beyond a contiguous state in the past 10 days.

- All attendees, regardless of vaccination status, must be masked at all times while inside Mabou Mines and The 122 Community Center. Patrons will be refused entry or asked to leave should they decline to wear a mask or appropriate face covering. Masks must fit securely to the face, covering both mouth and nose.
- Attendees are asked to maintain 6 feet of social distancing during the installation, and any time they are inside the building.
- No more than ten people shall travel through the theater at one time.
- We will provide a digital playbill that will be accessible via QR code/URL link on our website and will be emailed to all audience members who provide a valid email address upon making their reservation.
- There will be signage throughout the location to remind personnel and patrons/visitors to adhere to proper hygiene, social distancing rules, appropriate use of PPE, and cleaning and disinfection protocols.
