



MABOU MINES COVID-19 PROTOCOL

- Attendees are asked to stay home if they answer yes to any of the following questions:
 - a) do you have a fever above 100 degrees; b) have you tested positive for COVID within the last 14 days; c) do you have any of the well-known COVID symptoms d) have you been exposed to anyone who's tested positive in last 14 days, e) have you traveled outside of the state, beyond a contiguous state in the past 10 days.
- All attendees, regardless of vaccination status, must be masked at all times while inside Mabou Mines and The 122 Community Center. Masks must fit securely to the face, covering both mouth and nose. Patrons will be unable to enter if they are not wearing a mask.
- Attendees are asked to maintain 6 feet of social distancing during the installation, and any time they are inside the building.
- No more than ten people shall travel through the installation at one time.
- We will provide a digital playbill that will be accessible via QR code/URL link on our website and at check in.
- Hand sanitizer available at the check in.
- There will be signage throughout the location to remind personnel and patrons of these safety measures.
